The Petít Moulín communal pond

Petit Moulin that depended on the castle of 'La Brosse' disappeared in the 17th century, only a fragment of grinding stone remains in the foundations of an old bridge.

Many springs outcrop in the valley; between 1918 and 1940, a hydraulic ram ascended a spring water toward Persac's old water tower, which fed the standpipes, until 2008, springs and in particular that of Fontaudon provided drinking water to the town. Today, they feed the artificial pond, with the Petite Blourde as an outlet.

The pond built in a steep-sided and wooded site in the Small Blourde' valley, offers many resources:

- a lake with angling
- a touristic hall
- picnic tables
- a natural camping area
- children's games
- a paddling pool
- a fitness trail
- hiking trails

The valorisation of the Petit Moulin's pond surroundings contributes to Persac's tourist attraction.
